To be a candidate for a Water Control and Improvement District (WCID) board in Texas, an individual must meet several eligibility requirements primarily outlined in the Texas Water Code and Election Code.

**General Qualifications**

To be eligible for election or appointment to a WCID Board of Directors, a person must be a U.S. citizen, at least 18 years old, and a resident citizen of Texas. They must also either own land subject to taxation in the district or be a qualified voter within the district. Additionally, candidates cannot have been declared totally mentally incapacitated by a final court judgment, partially mentally incapacitated without the right to vote, or have an unpardoned felony conviction.

**Candidacy Filing Process**

To appear on the ballot, candidates must submit an application. This application must be filed within a specific timeframe before the election, which is typically 78 days prior to the election date for a May election. Write-in candidates have a different deadline for filing a Declaration of Write-In Candidacy. A recent law mandates that candidates affirm on their application that they have not been finally convicted of a felony or that their rights have been restored; providing false information is a Class B Misdemeanor.
